

"Hatred", Shiite mystical teaching

Abstract

Mysticism, in its general sense, encompasses all transcendental issues. But in its intra-religious concept, it has unique features, such as monotheism in Islamic mysticism. If we believe in a special mysticism called Shiite mysticism with the Ahlul Bayt (AS), this mysticism will have special sources and, as a result, unique teachings, without being seen in other mysticisms or being presented with a Shiite structure and atmosphere. "Hatred" is among the mystical teachings of the Shiites. And in this article, the issue of "hatred in Shiite mysticism" is explained and analyzed. In the present study, three specific tasks are performed: Explaining the title "hatred" in the two arcs of ascent and descent, specifying the manifestation of the name "hatred", and distinguish between mystical hatred and theological hatred. The present article is written by analytical method. The basis of this analysis, following the method of mystics and mystic researchers in Islamic mysticism, is to document mystical perceptions to Quranic verses and original mystical Shiite hadiths. In addition, an attempt has been made to use the mystical sources of the early and influential Shiite mystics.
